Line 2 of Form TD1NT – Age amount			
If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2022, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$39,826 and \$90,726, calculate your partial claim as follows:			
Maximum amount			1
Your estimated net income for the year	-	2	
Base amount	-	3	
Line 2 minus line 3 (if negative, enter "0")	=	4	
Applicable rate	x	5	
Multiply line 4 by line 5.	=	6	-
Line 1 minus line 6			
Enter this amount on line 2 of Form TD1NT.	=	7	
Line 8 of Form TD1NT – Caregiver amount			
If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$17,670 and \$22,844, calculate your partial claim as follows:			
Base amount			1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year	-	2	
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$5,174, if negative, enter "0")	=	3	
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of Form TD1NT for this dependant.	-	4	
Line 3 minus line 4 (if negative, enter "0")			
Enter this amount on line 8 of Form TD1NT.	=	5	
Line 9 of Form TD1NT – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older			
You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NT. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$7,341 and \$12,515, calculate your partial claim as follows:			
Base amount			1
Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year	-	2	
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$5,174, if negative, enter "0")	=	3	
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of Form TD1NT for this dependant.	-	4	
Line 3 minus line 4 (if negative, enter "0")			
Enter this amount on line 9 of Form TD1NT.	=	5
