




Tłıchǫ First Nation Tax

At the time of printing, a tax administration and sharing agreement was being discussed that could lead to Canada sharing part of the federal income tax payable by all residents of Tłıchǫ lands and Tłıchǫ communities.

Such an agreement may be implemented between Canada and the Tłıchǫ on or before December 31, 2004. If so, the Canada Revenue Agency will use Tłıchǫ residency information to administer the agreement for the First Nation.

All Tłıchǫ residents have to identify themselves by ticking “Yes” in the Northwest Territory First Nation information box on page 1 of the 2004 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.

Individuals and Tłıchǫ citizens who live elsewhere, have to tick “No” in the Northwest Territory First Nation information box on page 1 of the 2004 *Income Tax and Benefit Return*.
