

Your Canada Child Tax Benefit

What's new?

The enclosed notice shows you how much you will receive starting in July 2010 based on your family's net income in 2009.

Automated Benefits Application – You can now apply for the Canada Child Tax Benefit (CCTB) at the same time you register your newborn with a participating province or territory. For more information on this new service, go to www.cra.gc.ca/aba.

Check your notice carefully

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) needs up-to-date information to accurately calculate benefits and to avoid unnecessary delays in sending you your benefits.

Tell us immediately when a change occurs to one of the following:

- your marital status;
- the number of children in your care;
- information concerning your bank account and direct deposit;
- your home address or mailing address; and
- your and/or your spouse or common-law partner's residency or immigration status.

Out-of-date information can cause an overpayment on an account. An overpayment is deducted from your future benefit payments and tax refunds—up to 100% of your benefits or refunds—until the overpayment is paid in full.

Important

To receive the CCTB, you and your spouse or common-law partner must each file an income tax return every year, even if you have no income to report.

Online services

My Account – You can apply or manage personal information related to your CCTB and related provincial and territorial programs, goods and services tax/harmonized sales tax credit (GST/HSTC), Universal Child Care Benefit (UCCB), and income tax accounts.
